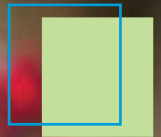

Steps Ahead for Youth



Steps Ahead for Youth is conducted in partnership with several public high schools in the metro area and is a one-year mentoring program for 9th & 10th grade students.

The program sets itself apart from other mentoring organizations by delivering the following:

- /// Both community and one-on-one mentoring
- /// 4 day launch course retreat in the mountains
- /// High ropes course experience
- /// A 12-month series of community workshop sessions for mentors and youth
- /// Individualized coaching
- /// Support through graduation if desired

Who joins Steps Ahead?

- /// Youth in the 9th & 10th Grades
- /// Youth who want academic support at school
- /// Youth who want support with difficult circumstances at home, neighborhood, school
- /// Youth interested in changing the way they live their lives
- /// Youth interested in changing their future!

On average 60% of Steps Ahead participants improve their GPA, 40% improve their attendance and 70% decrease the number of referrals and suspensions during the program.



How does it work?

Step 1 is the launch course, which gives the youth an opportunity to examine their lives away from their everyday environment and confront past issues. Relationships between youth and mentors are developed and strengthened.

Step 2 happens when the youth and mentor are paired one-on-one. Mentoring provides support for the youth to stay engaged and accomplish the goals that they create for themselves.

Step 3 includes a series of community workshops which provide structure and a place to practice the core principles that were introduced at the launch course.

What's happens next?

The Touchstone Program is a 2-3 year follow-up program to Steps Ahead designed to support students all the way through graduation. The Touchstone Program is offered ONLY to graduates of Steps Ahead and focuses on the following:

- /// Continued one-on-one mentoring
- /// Continued monthly community workshops
- /// Specialized training in relationships, leadership and life beyond high school
- /// Support with college, scholarships and careers, etc.

Colorado Youth at Risk has a proven track record over the last 4 years with 95% of youth participating in CYAR programs staying in school.
